Deadline for submitting stall / racing applications is Friday, March 1, 2023.

An up to date Coggins test (within the last 12 months) must be on file with the USTA Electronic eligibility system or the race office. No entries will be accepted without it.

A "release of liability" waiver or proof of Workmen's Compensation Insurance must be on file with the race office from all trainers and their employees prior to any horse being accepted.

Payment Information

All forms related to purse checks from the previous year remain in the purse check system. New forms must be submitted prior to purse payments, if your bank information changes or you have changed addresses. All forms are available to be downloaded and submitted via the web site. If Direct Deposit is not used, Horsemen can pick up checks in the Paddock Admin Office on Mondays between 1pm-3pm. Checks will not be held. If horsemen do not pick up their checks, it will be mailed to the address on file.

Racing applications:

- An application to race at Oak Grove, listing all the horses you wish to race at the 2023 meet, must be on file in the race office by March 1, 2023 to be classified. Any application received after the deadline will be approved for the next race week at the discretion of the Racing Secretary.
- All horsemen may call the race office beginning Monday, March 13th at 270-498-4330 or Kevin Mack at 765-621-8050 regarding their application status.
- If a horse is taken off the roster, or is taken to another track to race without the permission of the race secretary, the horse may be used to fill races at the discretion of the race secretary.
- The trainer is solely responsible for filing the necessary paperwork to withdraw from or add horses to his/her list.
- Overnight Barn Opens March 26th 2023 and Closes July 9th 2023
- Stall payments for the 1st month will be paid upon arrival, 2nd payment due May 9th, and 3rd payment due June 13th
- All Stalls must be stripped down when vacating. Any Stalls not stripped will be charged a \$50 fee and possibly forfeit receiving stalls in the future

Required Health Documentation

- An up-to-date Coggins test (within 12 months) must be on file with the USTA electronic eligibility system and the race office @ Oak Grove prior to post time or the horse will be scratched.
- If you have a recent up-to-date Coggins test, not yet on file with the USTA, you may leave a copy with security at the stable gate, where we will update the file. If your horse has no paper work, you will be denied access to the grounds.

- Horses are required to have an up to date Certified Veterinarian Inspection (CVI) or Health Certificate. Out of State Horses are required within 3 days/ 72 Hours. In State Horses are required within 10 days.
- Documentation of Equine Herpes Virus (EHV) vaccine within 6 months must be presented.

Training Information:

- Training days for the season have been established- Starting March 27, 2023- July 9, 2023
- Training times are 6 am until 1 pm
- Track is CLOSED FRIDAYS
- A contact/emergency phone number must be left on your purse authorization form.
- While utilizing the track for training, a helmet and appropriate clothing MUST be worn.
- Towing and/ or ponying horses is NOT PERMITTED at any time.
- Track schedule may change due to amphitheater schedule. 24 hour notice minimum will be given.
- Track will open June 16th and Closed on June 17th due to booked event at Amphitheater. Please plan accordingly for this change.
- Equestrian Center warm up arenas may not to be used.

Qualifying:

- Pace: 2:04
- Trot: 2:06
- Two seconds allowed for two year olds
- One second allowed for three year olds
- Qualifying races: prior to the meet beginning, the (two) qualifiers will be held on Monday, April 3rd @ Noon and Monday, April 10th @ Noon. During the meet, all Mondays afterwards. To be raced prior to first race post.
- Box will Close on Sunday @ 12pm Noon CST
- Horses placed on the stewards list for sickness/lameness may not race for seven days (Horses scratched Sunday are not eligible to race until the following Sunday)

***Please note-very important: 45 Day Rule will be in effect for all races.

Claiming races:

- Horses in claiming races will not be allowed to move up in price unless 1st or 2nd in their last claiming start, or at the discretion of the race secretary.
- If a horse is scratched from a claiming race at any track, they must go back in for the same claiming price or lower in their next start
- No horses may enter to race without first approval from the race secretary prior to entering.
- All claims must be made with cash or certified check. All claims must be submitted to the Oak Grove race office located in the race day stable, under surveillance. A claimed horse may not be raced outside the state until 30 days expire from the date of the claim or the meet ends.

The claiming funds must reflect the purchase price of the horse and 6% KY state tax and the usta transfer fee of \$40.00.

Claims must be made 20 minutes before post time for the race in which the horse is participating.

General:

- A horse entered in a class to which it is not eligible may be listed as not eligible and left out, or transferred to another class at the discretion of the race secretary
- Entering horses in classes where not eligible, or with no knowledge of which classes are eligible to race in, or attempting to make entries without a condition sheet may result in the entries not being accepted
- Oak Grove reserves the right to rule a horse too competitive, non-competitive and may also rule a horse off the grounds.

- During racing all equipment must be well kept, cleaned and maintained. (Including driving colors)
- When making entries, trainers need to list 3 drivers.
- Trainers stabled at the track must keep their stable area and stalls clean or they may be fined.
- Trainers that Ship In are required to strip their stalls and stable area when leaving the property.
- Horsemen staying at the RV Park must pay their bill timely, at the front desk, or removal from the property is possible. While staying at the RV Park, spaces are to be kept clean and it is expected that horsemen be respectful of other visitors.

ATTENTION HORSEMEN:

ALL HORSEMEN MUST BE FAMILIAR WITH THE REGULATIONS OF THE STATE OF KENTUCKY HORSE RACING COMMISSION AND THE UNITED STATES TROTTING ASSOCIATION

ALL OWNERS, TRAINERS, DRIVERS AND GROOMS MUST HAVE A CURRENT KENTUCKY HORSE RACING LICENSE (ALSO A USTA LICENSE FOR O-T-D). THIS ALSO APPLIES TO QUALIFIERS.

QUALIFYING DRIVERS MUST WEAR FULL COLORS. TO RECEIVE FULL CREDIT FOR THEIR DRIVES.

HORSEMEN ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCTING OF THEIR BUSINESS. THEY MUST CONTACT THE JUDGES TO DETERMINE THE STATUS OF THE ALSO ELIGIBLE HORSES AND LEAVE A CURRENT PHONE NUMBER WHERE THEY MAY BE REACHED. IT IS THE TRAINER'S OBLIGATION TO CHECK WITH THE JUDGES PRIOR TO SCRATCH TIME TO NAME THE PROPER DRIVER.

ANY RULES OR CIRCUMSTANCES THAT HAVE NOT BEEN ADDRESSED BY THE ABOVE RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL BE COVERED UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE HOST ASSOCIATION OR THE KENTUCKY HORSE RACING COMMISSION.
